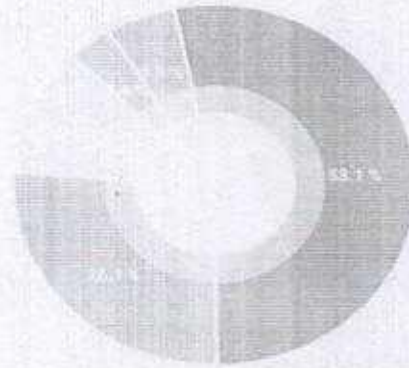

5. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



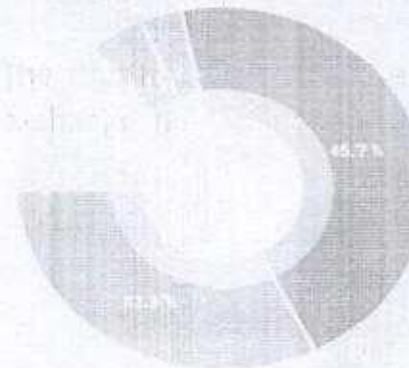

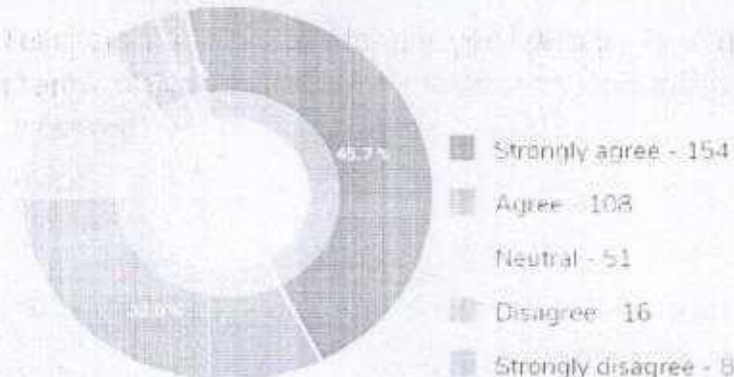
9. The teacher identify your strength and encourage you with providing right level of challenges



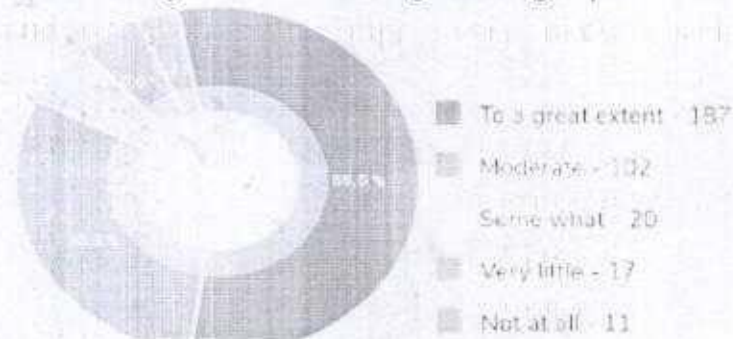
10. Teachers are able to identify your weakness and help you to overcome them

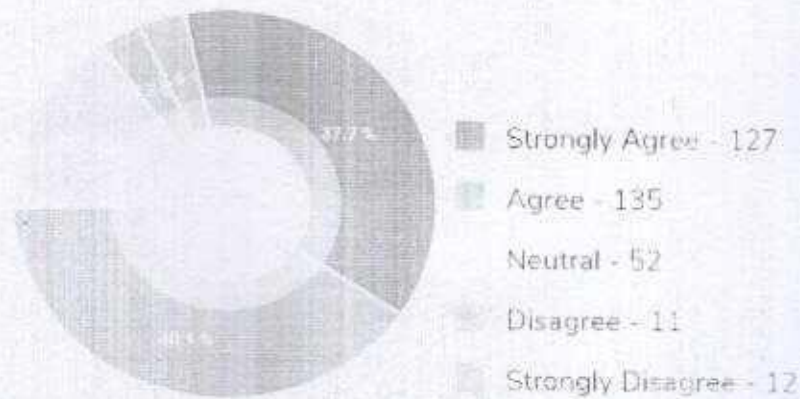
17. What is your opinion regarding library facilities of the college?



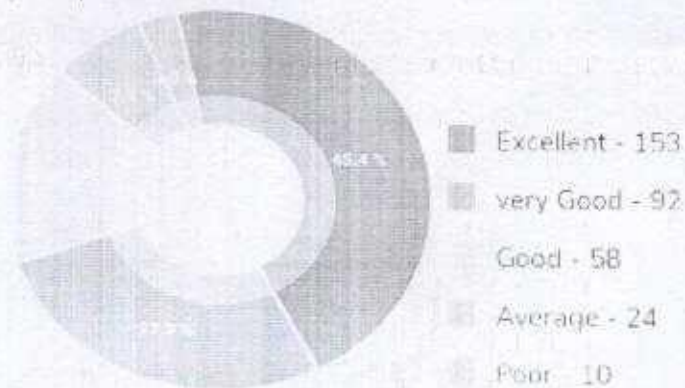
18. How do you evaluate the laboratory and infrastructure facilities of the college?

OBSERVATIONS:

- ❖ About 85% of the students responded are satisfied regarding the in time completion of the course.
- ❖ More than 90% of the students are satisfied with the preparedness of teachers and more than 83% reported that the teachers communicate effectively.
- ❖ The fairness of the examination, evaluation process and in-time publication of result is well applauded by about 92% of the students and about 80% of the responding students have reported that their performance in assignments are regularly discussed with them for their better benefit.
- ❖ The initiatives of the institute in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities are well applauded by the students.

- ❖ The teaching and mentoring process of the institution in facilitating cognitive social and emotional growth is well accepted by about 78% of the students responded.
- ❖ The provision of multiple opportunities to learn and grow as offered by the institution is well accepted by 78% of the respondents.
- ❖ The illustration of the concepts through examples and applications as adopted by teachers of the institution satisfies 88% of the responding students.
- ❖ The contribution of the teacher in identifying the strength of the students and its encouragement by providing right level of challenges is appreciated by 85% the responding students.
- ❖ The efforts of the teachers in identifying the weakness among the students and to overcome them are praiseworthy.
- ❖ The effort of the institution in engaging students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process is appreciated by 78% of the respondents.
- ❖ The methodology adopted by the teachers in the teaching learning process is accepted by the responding students to an extent of 86%.
- ❖ The hostel facility of the college is moderately accepted by 78% of the responding students and needs to be improved.
- ❖ Efforts by the institution for improving employability skill of the students is accepted by about 84% of the responding students and needs to be improved.
- ❖ Use of ICT tools in teaching learning process by the teachers is moderate and needs to be improved.
- ❖ The library facility of the institution needs to be improved.

- ❖ The adequacy of the laboratory and infrastructure facility of the college is reported as good by about 80% of the responding students.
- ❖ About 78% of the responding students agree with the cooperative attitude of the non-teaching staff members.
- ❖ About 90% students satisfied with the system of examination, evaluation and in time publication of results.



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
