


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?


2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?


3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?


4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




















16. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities


17. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you reedy for the world of work


18. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projectors, multimedia, etc. while teaching.
